2017 INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS AND ASSESSMENTS FOR SCHOOLS (ICAS)

This year, at Windsor, we are offering the students the opportunity to enter five different academic competitions/assessments within the International Competitions and Assessments scheme. Following on from last year, ALL year 2-6 students will complete the SCIENCE exam as part of our assessment framework.

These assessments provide an opportunity for students from Years 2 to 6 to gain a measure of their own achievement in an external assessment situation. It provides schools and teachers with comprehensive reporting of results and also gives parents helpful information regarding their child's performance.

The competitions take place each year in schools throughout Australia, New Zealand and the Pacific Region. This note informs you of the available competitions that your child is invited to participate in.

All students receive a certificate and an individual student report indicating which questions they answered correctly as well as where they average across Queensland. The documents are suitable for inclusion in a portfolio. The student report is also useful for highlighting student strengths and weaknesses in the skills and processes of these academic areas.

Certificates are awarded for each subject area as follows:

- High Distinction to the top 1% of entrants
- Distinction to the next 10% of entrants
- Credit to the next 25% of entrants
- Participation to all other participating students

All students who achieve the highest score in each state/region receive a UNSW medal. These medals may be presented at UNSW Medal Ceremonies or at a school assembly.
