
New online child care management system for Helping Hands Windsor parents

The Federal Government's New Child Care Package

From 2 July 2018, the Federal Government is introducing a New Child Care Package. The Package will help parents with children aged 0-13 work, train, study and volunteer. The Package includes a new Child Care Subsidy, which replaces the current Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate. It will be paid directly to services.



Your information does not automatically rollover to the new package and you may not receive any subsidy if your assessment is not completed. You must provide some new information and confirm your current details using your Centrelink online account through myGov. You should do this as soon as possible.

What you need to do:



Sign into your Centrelink online account through myGov.



Select Complete your Child Care Subsidy assessment task.



Work through the steps to **provide new information** and **confirm** your current details.
