

# Yr 4-6 iPad SURVEY SNAPSHOT

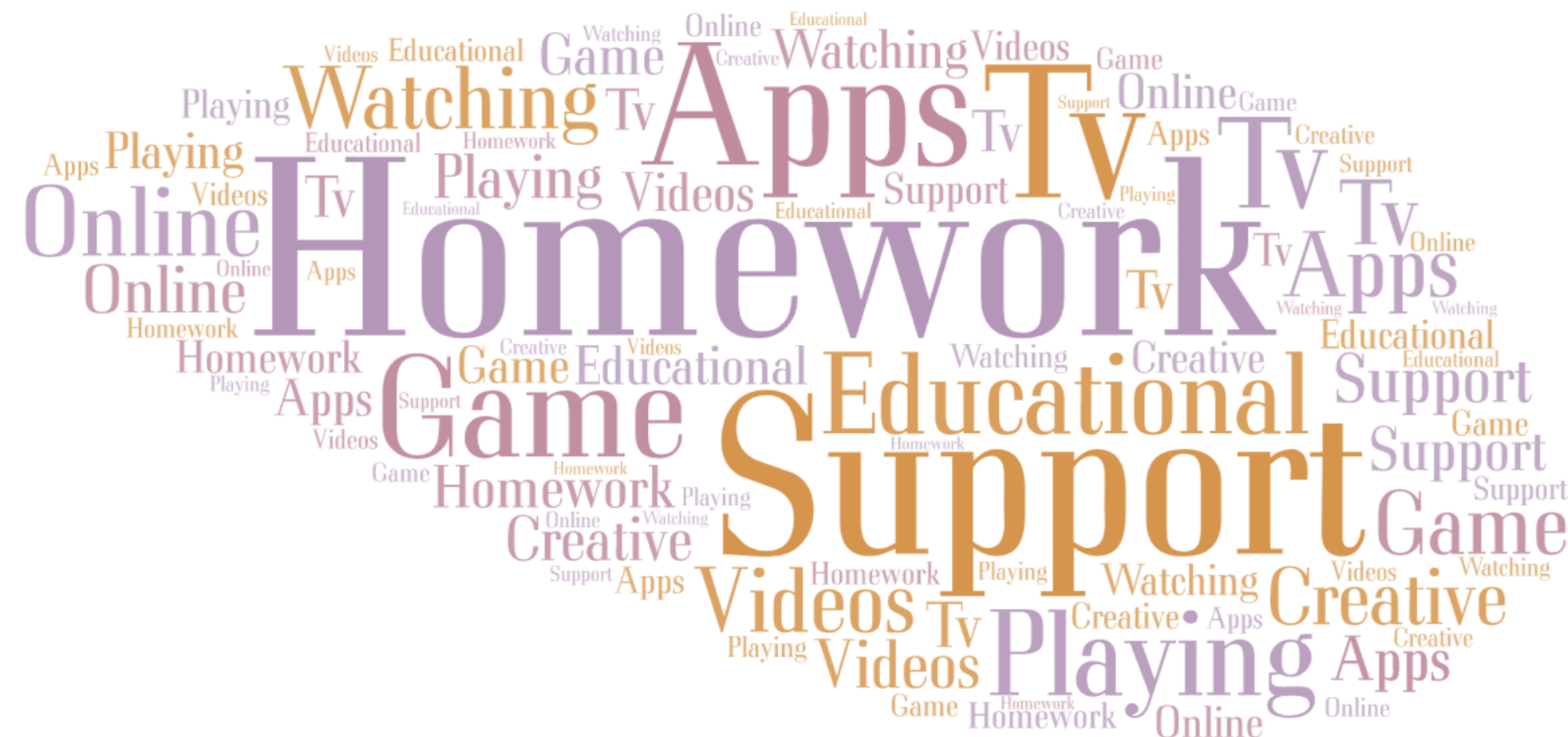

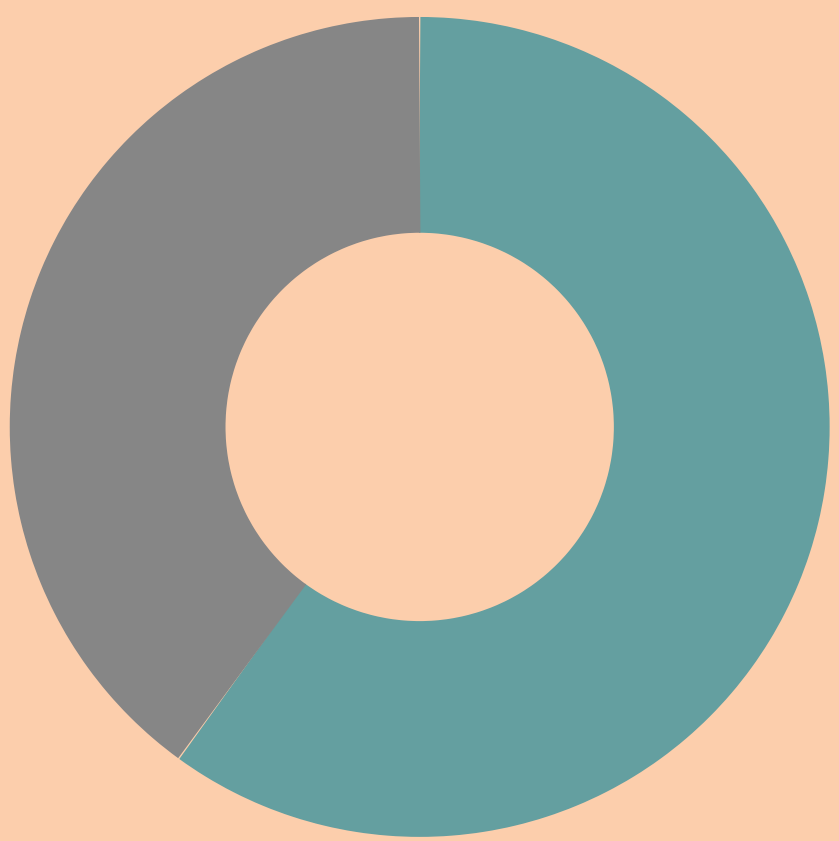
Your reported uses of the device at home before the program....

60% reported that they have gained an insight into how learning is enhanced with the device.

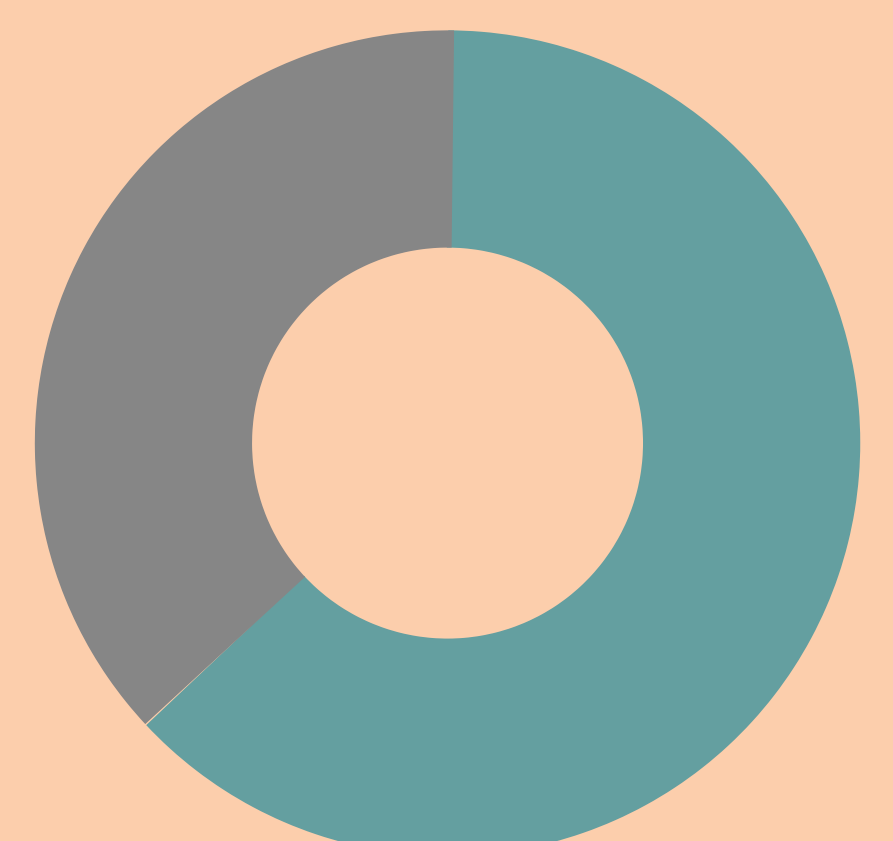
